Supply List- Airbrush

1. Notebook or sketchpad, pencils and eraser for drawing
2. Smock or old shirt
3. Plain white cotton fabric, approx. 2 yd.
4. Cutting mat
5. Number 11 exacto blades (pkg of 5) and handle
6. Roll of freezer paper
7. Respirator for dust/mist, paint and spray. 3M and Paasche make them. Make sure you have the one for paint spray.

They charge \$29.95 for Model "99 99 Paint and Vapor Respirator.
